The Tulsa Pipe Trades Training School trains students to fabricate, install, and service complex plumbing, heating, air conditioning and process piping systems. These systems deliver safe and comfortable living and working environments.

Some highlights of our program include:

- A structured environment of learning.
- **No cost for 1080 hours of classroom training.**
- Discounted textbook pricing.
- Paid on the job training (Current starting apprentice pay is \$13.97 per hour and includes **health insurance** and a raise every 6 months if requirements are met)
- Students will work for an employer during the day and attend class 2 nights a week September thru May.
- Course work includes math, science, blueprint reading, welding, gas installations, back flow prevention, rigging and safety and many others.
- The school will afford the student the opportunities to receive **32 hours of college credits** from Washtenaw Community College in Michigan.
- After completion of the program the student will be ready to take the state Mechanical or Plumbing Journeyman's test.
- Licensed Journeymen that work for our employers currently make \$26.86 + 10.86 in fringe benefits per hour.

PLUMBING, PIPEFITTING & HVAC/REF. APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Applications for Plumber, Pipefitter-Welder and HVAC/REF. Apprentices are available on a year round basis from the Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee of the Tulsa Pipe Trades Training School.

The qualifications for Apprentice Applicants are:

18 years of age at the time of interview, and submit proof of birth date and I.D. with their application. (State Certified Birth Certificate preferred)

High School Graduate, or have a G.E.D. Certificate.

Include a High School Transcript or the official G.E.D. Certificate and Official Test Scores Report with their completed application when returned.

Appear for an Interview Session when scheduled by Tulsa Pipe Trades Training School.

Military Veterans and graduates of technical training schools should inquire about direct entry provisions.

The Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee expects to accept 20 new Pipe Trades Apprentices into the Apprenticeship and Training Program each year.

Applicants will be selected based on highest qualifications, without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or age. (Except Minimum Age)
